CATCH UP ON LIFE

Have someone read one (or all) of these verses. (1 Thessalonians 2:8, Romans 12:10 and 15)

- What was the best part of your week? What was the hardest part of your week?
- Are there any ways you have noticed God working?

Kids, make sure you ask these questions to your parents as well!

LESSON DISCUSSION

Have someone read one (or all) of these verses. (2 Timothy 3:16-17, Colossians 1:9-12 and James 1:22-25)

PAUL BECAME A MISSIONARY ACTS 14

- Who were the main people in the story? Where were they?
- What do you remember from the story you learned about on Sunday?

Discuss it!

- How does this story point back to Jesus?
- Why does God call missionaries? Remind kids that a missionary is a Christian chosen by God who obeys His command to go and tell another group of people the good news of Jesus. Discuss how missionaries are called to share the gospel because there may not be another Christian presence. Remind kids that all people need to hear the gospel to have an opportunity to trust in Jesus.

ENGAGE THE HEART

Have someone read one (or all) of these verses. (John 15:4, James 5:16, 1 John 1:5-10, 1 John 1:9)

- How do you need God's help this week?
- Is there any sin we need to confess to Jesus and ask Him to forgive us?

REVIEW THE MISSION

Have someone read one (or all) of these verses! (John 20:21 and 2 Corinthians 5:18-20)

- Who is someone who needs God's love and how can we show it to them?

Want Family Mission Ideas? Here is one that relates to this week's lesson!

- Work together to make a list of everything you would need for a trip to a park, beach, or campsite. Plan the route to take to the destination. Visit the destination if possible. Note how many supplies are needed, remind kids that a journey like Paul's was much more challenging. Even though it was hard, Paul knew that the gospel message was worth it!

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together as a family. You can pray short prayers like, "God, thank you for" or "God, help me with" or "God, I'm sorry for..."

In light of our lesson, pray for missionaries who are sharing the gospel to people groups around the world. Ask God to keep them safe as they tell others about Jesus. How can the work of missionaries help us to be bolder in sharing the gospel with others?
